## Jockfall Fishing & Activities

Offers accommodation, food, fishing gear and souvenirs.

Jockfall is the place for anyone who enjoys outdoor life, fishing, or magnificent nature. Here you can find Jockfallet waterfall, which with its 9-metre drop makes up the highest threshold in the Kalix River. The river has its source near Kebnekaise, the highest mountain in Sweden, and makes its way 46 Swedish miles southeast before ending in the sea just outside of Kalix.

The Kalix River is one of the untouched and protected national rivers in Sweden and was crowned National River in 1993. This is a very important protection for the river and prohibits the building of power stations along the river. The Kalix River offers very varied fishing with grayling, trout, whitefish, pike, and first and foremost salmon! Jockfall is well-known as one of the best angling and salmon fishing sites in Europe. It's not unusual to reel in salmon of up to 20 kilos. Apart from fishing the area offers various other outdoor activities, such as hiking, biking, and snowmobiling. Or why not simply enjoy the beautiful surroundings of the village and the waterfall!? And don't forget to visit the salmon ladder, which aids the salmon on their way to their spawning grounds.

## **Fattenborg.** . (Långsel 17km)

Settlement 4000 years old

The area is accessible to visitors even when the exhibition building is closed. Along the handicapped-accessible path and in the surrounding area, there are archaeological information signs and a barbecue

area. Adjacent to the information building is a cleaning room and a shed. The site area is a nature reserve and a nature trail with information signs is also found along the span. When measuring settlement mounds, dates from 1,500–2,000 BC are reported. From historical times when the coastal landscape turned into a forest landscape, there are a large number of Sami hearths.

The nature reserve consists for the most part of heath-type pine forest and moraine islands surrounded by bogs. The former shoreline and sea coves are clearly visible in the area. The area is strongly affected by land elevation.

A nature trail with information signs can be found along the handicap-accessible span. Archaeological signs are also posted. The span leads to a shelter from the wind with a fireplace by the pond. There is also a fireplace in the hut near the information building. It is not permitted to make fires other than in designated places.

It is also not permitted to damage the many ancient remains or the animal and plant life. Think about the rights of the public and take care of nature!

## **Siknäsfortet (ca: 11km)**

Invasion defense facility for Töre harbour. Cafe and souvenirs.

Forty meters down under the Hömyr mountain at the Siknäs peninsula you will find a top secret subterranean fortress, which was built for the defense of Töre harbour, the most northern deep-water harbour in Sweden, as well as to delay an enemy advance towards using the E4 road towards the Boden fortress (the main defense point of Northern Sweden).

### **EXPERIENCE THE COLD WAR & THE KALIX DEFENSE LINE**

The bunker is a fantastic experience with its unique background and the stories of both its every day life as well as the secret construction of the defense against an invasion. Inside the museum You will also find exhibitions from the days of the Cold War.

## **Hyttgården (ca: 3 km)**

Museum Industrial epoch 1799-1960, Cafe

Töre began to grow properly at the beginning of the 19th century when Törefors mill was established in 1799 by Baron Samuel Gustaf Hermelin. From the beginning, the mill consisted of a sawmill, forge and mill. Later, Norrland's largest blast furnace and Norrbotten's first ore railway were also added. Seven buildings in original condition from the mill remain today in the homestead area.

## **Suggestions for interesting day stages with different lengths/times for Midsummersail.**

**1. Short guided tour.** (23km) Time 2.5 - 3 hours (Töre harbor – Hyttgården Töre – Siknäsfortet Siknäs – Töre harbor.)

### **1a. Short guided tour.** (17 km) Time 1,5 -2 hours (Töre harbor - Fattenborg - Töre harbor)
